

## **WELCOME SKATERS TO THE 2008 CALALTA SPRING SCHOOL**

Welcome back from your holiday! We are looking forward to an exciting and productive spring school. I want to take a few moments to welcome any new skaters from other clubs or from our Canskate program. We at Calalta offer a productive, friendly, and professional environment for you to train and to have fun. I wanted to outline a few rules that you may or may not know.

1. You must register for all sessions that you skate. Please have your parents talk to the rink chairperson or Natalie in the office prior to you stepping on the ice. Pick up passes are available.
2. Please do not get on the ice prior to your scheduled time or stay on past your session especially if the zamboni man is waiting for you!
3. We have designated locker rooms for Girls and Boys. Please change and put on your skates in the appropriate room.
4. Session levels have changed a little this year. Please make sure you are signed up for the appropriate session. Exceptions must be approved by the Director of Skating ONLY.
5. Make up sessions for skaters are not usually granted unless special circumstances. Please talk to Natalie or myself
6. Some sessions are extremely busy. Please follow the “rules of the road” with the spinning zone in the middle of the rink and jumps toward the ends. Remember to watch out for your fellow skaters at all times. Skaters in their program have the right of way but must be considerate to others as well. Please refrain from yelling “excuse me” to any other skater or coach unless in an emergency.
7. Keep the sessions moving and avoid unnecessary talking or standing around.
8. Familiarize yourself with the Skater Commitment form and Code of Behavior which you should have signed on the registration form.
9. Rude behavior will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave.
